Earn Eagle Required Merit Badges!

*Scouts may sign up for one, two or three merit badges. Each class is 1 1/2 hour long.

*Cost is \$40.00 per class for the entire week.

*Most merit badges listed below will be taught at 5:00 pm, 6:30 pm and 8:00 pm with the exception of Swimming and Lifesaving only to be taught at 5:00 pm and 6:30 pm.

*If taking Swimming or Lifesaving: Scout must be able to pass Camp Swim Test. Scout will not be taught to swim.

*Scouts are responsible to purchase their own merit badge books prior to attending camp. It's recommended that they familiarize themselves with the merit badge book prior to attending camp.

*Scouts are required to bring a merit badge workbook from www.sgvcbbsa.org. Go to the camping page, then click on merit badge helpers. These workbooks are required at camp.

**"Partial" for merit badges will be issued to Scouts who do not complete all of the requirements during the camp week. Please contact your Scoutmaster for the name of a merit badge counselor in your area to help complete the process.

*Please visit our website at www.sgvcbbsa.org, go to the camping page, then Camp Trask for information on prerequisites prior to attending camp. (Prerequisites are all requirements that can not be completed in the time you are at camp.)

*Your Scout will receive his class schedule, medical form, driving schedule up and down the mountain and a map to camp two weeks prior to the week he is attending.

Changes in merit badge classes can be made up to two weeks before your session starts, at which time the session will close. No class changes can be accepted after that. Please see the bottom of this flyer for refund policy.
